Mrs. Brasler is Vice President of Brasler Properties. She has demonstrated distinguished service to the University throughout many years. She served as a Drexel University Trustee from 1982 to 1998 and then was named an Emeritus Trustee in 2010. Mrs. Brasler has received several awards for her service to Drexel from the University's Alumni Association. These include the Golden Dragon Award (2010), the Rankin-Epstein Distinguished Alumni Award (1998), the Harriet E. Worrell Award (1993), and the Alumni Service Award (1970). In addition, the Sibby Merkel Brasler Design Fund was established in her honor at Westphal College. The fund has supported scholarships, travel stipends for students and faculty, and a speaker series. Mrs. Brasler continues her service to the University by serving as a member of the President's Board of Visitors, the Jacovini Award Committee and the Design Council of Westphal College. She previously served on the Space To Create Campaign Committee, the Reunion Committee of the Alumni Board of Governors, the Alumni Advocates, the Friends of Design Arts, the Sports Fans of the 50s, and the "Ink Not Ink" exhibition reception committee. In addition to her service to her alma mater, Mrs. Brasler has been the Benefit Coordinator of the Legacy Youth Tennis and Education Center (formerly the Arthur Ashe Youth Tennis and Education Center) for 20 years, where she has helped to raise over \$10 million. She has led numerous committees of the Philadelphia Orchestra and the Academy of Music. She has served on the boards of Young Audiences of Eastern Pennsylvania and Germantown Cricket Club. She is also a past president of the Parents Committee of the William Penn Charter School and was a Director of the Boys and Girls Philadelphia Tennis Championships.
